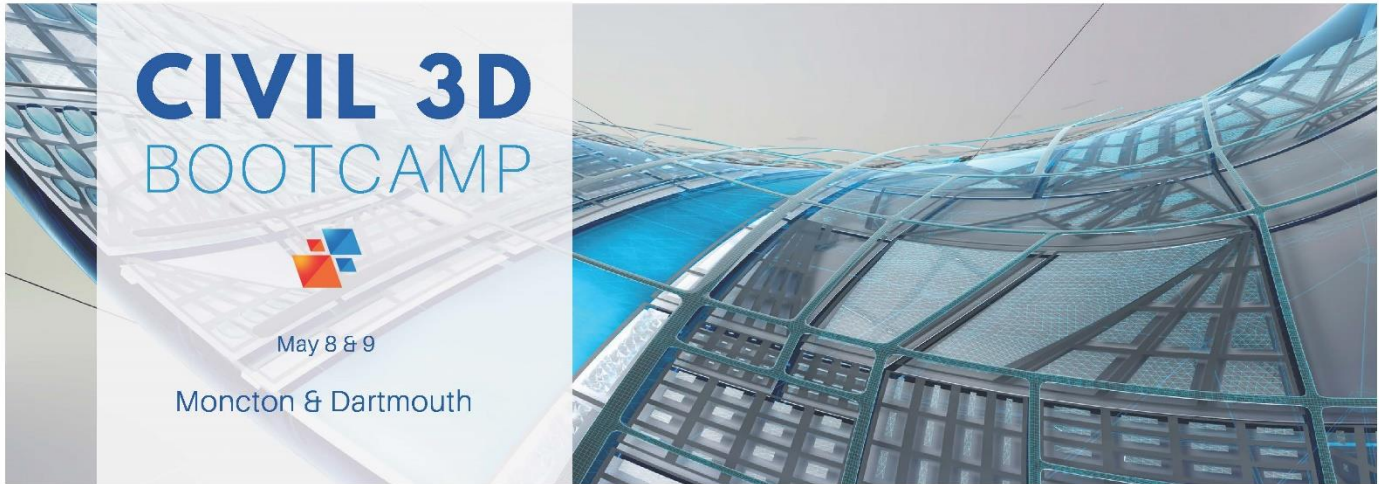
The Department of Transportation and Infrastructure (DTI), Buildings Division in collaboration with the Construction Association of New Brunswick (CANB) will be hosting information session in various areas of the Province. The objective of these sessions is to provide further detail and clarification on allowable charges related to change orders. DTI will also be introducing a new system where labour rates will be established on an annual basis for all construction companies (general contractors and sub-contractors) who do business with DTI Buildings Division.

This initiative will decrease disputes related to change orders, benefiting all parties. It is strongly recommended that each contractor endeavor to be in attendance at one of these sessions to be held on the following dates/locations:

Session 1: Introduction to Storm and Sanitary Analysis - Dealing with Stormwater (9:00 am - 10:00 am)

Autodesk® Storm and Sanitary Analysis (SSA) is an advanced, powerful and comprehensive modeling package for analyzing and designing urban drainage systems, storm sewers and sanitary sewers.

In this 60 minute session we will create storm drainage boundaries with Civil 3D pipe networks and export them to Autodesk Storm and Sanitary Analysis extension for analysis. We will explore methods of defining rainfall data and various hydrology and time of concentration parameters.

In addition, we will also analyze and edit the imported pipe network. Once the system has been refined, we will update the Civil 3D drawings with the pipe network information.

Session 2: Advanced Intersection Modeling (10:15 am - 11:00 am)

This session focus on the use of Civil 3D to perform common engineering tasks in modeling complex intersections. The objective is to demonstrate the recommended workflow and skills needed to manually create and edit a large roadway intersection. Topics include offset and connected alignments, superelevation, applying multiple horizontal and vertical targeting, using multiple baselines and regions.

Session 3: Civil 3D 2018.2 - New Features (11:15 am - 12 pm)

Join us to explore most recent enhancements to Civil 3D. (2018.2)!

There are a lot of "new" improvements such as; relative elevation feature lines, dynamic offset profiles, cross section buffers, connected alignments, corridor overlap resolution, pressure pipe catalog enhancements and much more. Don't miss out on the opportunity to learn more about these changes.

The Office of the Fire Marshal works closely with our stakeholders associated with the Plans Review process. Through discussions and feedback sessions we have recognized an opportunity for improvement with regards to the turnaround time for reviewing fire and sprinkler plans. As such the Office of the Fire Marshal is undergoing a six month pilot project targeted to enhance our plan review line of business.

Le Bureau du prévôt des incendies travaille étroitement avec ses partenaires qui prennent part au processus d'examen des plans de sécurité-incendie. À la lumière d'échanges et de séances de rétroaction, nous avons reconnu la nécessité d'améliorer le délai d'exécution pour réviser les plans de sécurité-incendie et de gicleurs. À cet effet, un projet pilote de six mois pour améliorer notre processus d'examen des plans est en cours au Bureau du prévôt des incendies.

The pilot project will consist of hiring an additional Plans Review Officer in conjunction with a continuous improvement project to ensure the process is ran as efficiently as possible. Our goal is to reduce our review time to avoid delays on time sensitive construction projects.

Dans le cadre du projet pilote, un agent d'examen des plans additionnel sera embauché et un projet d'amélioration continue pour veiller à ce que le processus soit le plus efficace possible sera mis en place. Notre objectif est de réduire notre temps d'examen afin de prévenir les retards dans les projets de construction dont les échéances sont serrées.

Throughout the next six months, we encourage all stakeholders to provide feedback to the Office of the Marshal in regards to your personal experiences; specifically focusing on turnaround time from final submission, while we continuously provide a high quality of service to all customers. Your feedback will greatly assist us with the evaluation of this pilot project.
