The trainee brings the essential knowledge of construction and construction practices and the Program the addresses all the aspects of managing, leading and directing each project to a successful and profitable outcome. A focal point for this special industry training is the knowledge and ability to "partner" with the Key Site Supervisor, so that together they are able to deliver the project through effective management of all the aspects of the construction. Each workshop is delivered in a format that involves questioning, sharing of information and experience and addressing real construction-site situations. Follow-up field assignments provide a learning vehicle for application of the key learnings and promote with skills development. The training delivery uses a comprehensive Training-Reference Manual which is intended to serve as a field reference and a vehicle for continuing application of the classroom learning.



The Canadian Construction Association released this statement this afternoon:

#### Targeted relief on Aluminium and Steel: Stability is still needed

OTTAWA, December 20, 2018 – The Canadian Construction Industry is encouraged by the Canadian Government's decision to provide relief on specific aluminum and steel products.

"Our industry has been hit hard over the last few months, and this relief will bring some much needed good news as we are working hard at building the infrastructure that Canadians need," said Mary Van Buren, President of CCA.

"As welcome as these measures are, this relief is temporary, and the uncertainty will still affect competitiveness and business confidence in Canada. The industry and investors need stability of a permanent solution to the ongoing trade dispute to allow them to better plan for the future" added Ms. Van Buren.

The CCA has long advocated for reciprocity and the establishment and maintenance of a free-flowing international system of trade, both regarding goods as well as services. CCA supports international free trade agreements, including provisions respecting government procurement.

## Feds announce apprenticeship grant program for women

December 21, 2018


The federal government has launched a grant program for women in the trades.

Registered apprentices in eligible Red Seal trades who have successful completed their first or second year/level can receive \$3,000 per year or level, up to a maximum amount of \$6,000.

Only women who have progressed in their training on or after April 1, 2018 are eligible. For those who progressed in 2018, the deadline is June 30, 2019. The deadline is 12 months after the date of progression for women who progressed after January 1, 2019.
